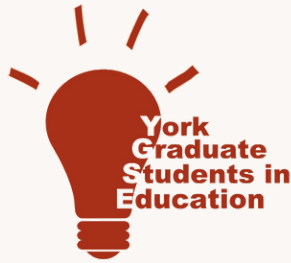

Our next issue will be published on March 8th and submissions are due by March 3rd. Going forward, the newsletter will be published on the first Friday of the month.



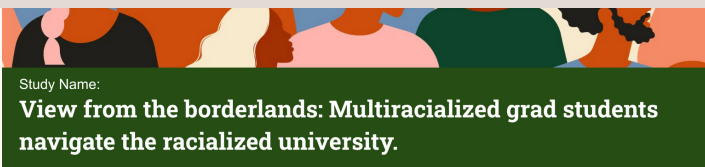
